\$509BILLION

The international trade in counterfeit and pirated goods amounted to as much as \$509 billion in 2016.

13 mm Doses

Europol seized 13 million doses of counterfeit medicine ranging from opioids to heart medication in March 2019.

10X SEIZURES

Seizures of counterfeit goods at U.S. borders have increased 10-fold from 3,244 to 33,810 per year since 2000.

16% a THREAT

16% of the contraband CBP and ICE/HSI seized in 2016 were direct threats to health and safety.

5% FAKE

During 3 "blitz" operations in 2019, CBP found that 5% of the 20,861 packages they inspected contained counterfeits, among them fake handbags, sports equipment, drivers licenses and deadly opioids.
