

# Colorado, October - December 2022

Fake pills made with fentanyl dominated the counterfeit medicine news out of Colorado in the latter part of 2022. Seizures happened in Mack, Colorado Springs, Firestone, Colorado City, Loveland, and Weld and Garfield counties. A 24-year-old woman in Fort Collins was poisoned and killed by a fentanyl pill in September, and <u>by early October, the state had already seen 20 children die</u> since the start of the year from fentanyl intoxication.

Dangerous fake medicine has found its way into Colorado from places other than street corners and social media apps. Sometimes, members of the medical profession have purchased medicine from unlicensed sources. Between 2012 and 2016, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration sent letters to 54 doctors and medical practices across Colorado warning them to stop buying medicine from known black market wholesalers. These letters referenced medicines to treat serious medical conditions such as cancer and osteoporosis. In 2021, three Colorado companies and two individuals were named in a lawsuit over the distribution of counterfeit HIV medicines to U.S. pharmacies. Additionally, Colorado is one of a handful of states looking to import medicines from Canada, <u>undermining the Drug Supply Chain Security Act</u>, and risking exposing its citizens to unreliable medicines.
