Connecticut, February 2022 – January 2023

Connecticut saw a steady stream of prosecutions and drug seizures related to counterfeit pills made with fentanyl or alprazolam (the active ingredient in Xanax) over the course of 2022. Federal courts sentenced counterfeit pill traffickers from five cities, including two men who ran a high-volume manufacturing operation in Stamford. Law enforcement seized pills in Hartford, Wethersfield and Windsor.

In the past, 25 medical practices in Connecticut were warned for buying black market cancer treatments or Botox. Pill press operations making a variety of counterfeit pills were busted in Norwich, Shelton, West Hartford, and Westport between 2013 and 2019, and three different illegal steroid suppliers were shut down between 2011 and 2017. In addition, two Connecticut suppliers were named in Gilead Sciences' lawsuit over the trafficking of <u>counterfeit HIV medicines</u> in 2021.
