Hawai'i, August - December 2022

While it took fentanyl longer to arrive in Hawai'i than it did on the mainland, it has been in Hawai'i for several years. Counterfeit pills made with fentanyl first appeared in 2018 and have been found on the islands frequently in the second half of 2022. Police arrested a Hilo pair in August who had allegedly been working with a Mexican national to bring fentanyl pills onto the Big Island. Another resident of the Big Island appeared in federal court in September to face charges of shipping fentanyl pills from Fresno, California to Keaau.

In October, a 15-year-old student at Kealakehe High School known only as "G" died after being poisoned by fentanyl. According to her mother, Kym, "G" ordered the deadly pill on Instagram and received it in the mail. "I'm convinced it was her first time, and I'm convinced it was one pill," Kym said.

Counterfeit medicine can also make its way to patients from legitimate sources. Between 2012 and 2017, seven doctors in Hawai'i received letters from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration warning them to stop purchasing medications such as cancer treatments and Botox from known black market wholesalers.
