Mississippi, January 2022 - January 2023

Counterfeit medicine news coming out of Mississippi has been sporadic since January 2022, but the issue of counterfeit pills made with fentanyl remained a constant throughout. In March, a Jackson man received a lengthy prison sentence for selling the counterfeit pill that killed 24-year-old Austin Elliot in February 2021. Law enforcement seized pills in Rankin County, Jackson, Tupelo, Batesville, and Tillabota.

Street corners and shady websites are not the only way that fake medicine has found its way to Mississippians. Sometimes, members of the medical profession have purchased medicine from unlicensed sources. Between 2012 and 2016, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration sent letters to 17 doctors and medical practices across Mississippi warning them to stop buying medicine from known black market wholesalers. These letters were in reference to cancer medications and Botox.
