New Mexico, July - December 2022

In the second half of 2022, fake pills made with fentanyl dominated counterfeit drug news in New Mexico. Sixteen search warrants issued as part of a federal investigation led to the seizure of over one million fentanyl pills in Albuquerque. Additionally, law enforcement seized fentanyl pills in Las Vegas, Santa Fe, Alamogordo, and Lincoln County. During a search of a vehicle at the port of Santa Teresa, agents with U.S. Customs and Border Protection seized 4,600 misbranded pills that a U.S. citizen was attempting to smuggle into the country.

Counterfeit medicine has also made its way into New Mexico when members of the medical profession purchased medicine from unlicensed sources. Between 2012 and 2016, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration sent letters to ten doctors and medical practices across New Mexico warning them to stop buying medicine from known black market wholesalers. These letters were in reference to cancer medications and Botox.
