

South Carolina, June 2022 - February 2023

Federal seizures of fentanyl in the Carolinas increased 15,000 percent from 2020 to 2022, and recent news about counterfeit prescription pills in South Carolina reflects that. Deputies with the York County Sheriff's Office seized 30 kilos of fentanyl and seven pill presses in Clover. Law enforcement found an eighth pill press and made fentanyl pill seizures of various sizes in Columbia, Greenwood and Lancaster. A Greenwood man died after taking a fake pill in June and three York County inmates were treated for fentanyl pill poisonings in September. Five people were sentenced for their participation in a Rock Hill-based operation that made and sold fake Roxicodone made of fentanyl in three states. Another defendant received a more-than-10-year sentence for providing fake Roxicodone that killed a Conway man.

The problem of counterfeit medicines isn't limited to fentanyl pills in South Carolina. In August, a Lexington man was sentenced for making and shipping unapproved workout supplements. The state has seen prosecutions for illegally imported Xanax, oxycodone, and ED drugs. Counterfeits may have made their way into medical practices as well: Between 2012 and 2016 the FDA warned 41 South Carolina doctors to stop buying cancer treatments and injectable medicines from unlicensed distributors that had been caught selling counterfeits.
