Texas, July 2022 - January 2023

Fake prescription pills have had a tremendous negative impact in Texas. Since July, law enforcement has seized fentanyl pills and/or pill presses across Texas and at its southern border. Related deaths were reported in Abilene, Cypress, San Antonio, Wichita Falls and Hays County, and on-base at Fort Hood. Law enforcement and public health and advocacy groups are working hard to improve the situation.

The problem isn't limited to fentanyl pills. Since 2020, four Texas companies were named in a lawsuit over sales of fake bottles of HIV medicines and authorities have busted drug rings making and selling fake cough syrup and fake Adderall made of methamphetamine. From 2012 to 2016, the FDA warned 253 Texan medical practices to stop buying from companies that had sold fake cancer and injectable medicines. Other major prescription drug counterfeiting cases in the state stretch back to 2007.
