Virginia, January – December 2022

Virginia has seen an uptick in incidents involving counterfeit pills made with fentanyl in the last year. Teens have died in Dale City, Manassas, Virginia Beach and Woodbridge and a toddler died in Gainesville. Authorities seized fentanyl pills in Culpeper, Haymarket and Ruckersville and sentenced defendants from cases involving past pill deaths in Ashland and Harrisonburg. Federal courts also sentenced the final defendant in a ring that sold fake Adderall made with methamphetamine.

Virginia has a significant and varied history with counterfeit drugs: 17 Virginian men were hospitalized after taking a supplement that contained an undeclared diabetes drug and authorities shut down an illicit steroids and fake medicine lab in Springfield (2019). A company in Arlington sold more than \$12.4 million in medications shipped from unreliable sources in India, Switzerland, and Turkey (2009 –2015). Fairfax County residents were sickened by medicines that had allegedly been smuggled from Central America (2011). Between 2012 and 2015, the FDA warned 45 different medical practices in Virginia to stop buying Botox and cancer treatments from unlicensed sources that had been caught selling counterfeits.
